#### **SUMMARY OF THE POSTAL REFERENDUM ON THE 2008 ISGF WORLD CONFERENCE**

*Question 1: do you agree that the decision taken in 2005 at Lillehammer concerning the 2008 World Conference in Tunisia be cancelled?*

Countries voting *on question one*: 42 out of 59, or 71, 19%  
Total number of votes: 168  
Yes: 130 votes 77,38 %  
No: 32 votes 19,05 %  
Abstain: 6 votes 3,57 %

*Question 2: if the overall result on question 1 is YES, which one of these NSGFs you would like to be the organiser of the World Conference?*

Countries voting *on question two*: 37 out of 59, or 62, 72%  
Total number of votes:  
Austria: 108 votes 72,97 %  
Iceland: 32 votes 21,62%  
Abstain: 8 votes 5,40%

According to these results the Tellers Committee records the following:

1. The cancellation of the decision made at Lillehammer regarding the World Conference 2008.
2. The choice of the NSGF to host the World Conference 2008: Austria.
